<u>1933 August 29:</u> KF to Suleiman – wants to put children in boarding school or live alone Translation summary by Salim Tamari 4/08:

Dear Husband (Cousin):

The school asked for 72 English pounds so the children can board at the school. Please send money. Your parents and everyone is in good shape. You must know that if you want your children to have a proper education then I have to be alone and not with your family. Because I cannot do anything when I am with the family. The school costs 15 English pounds for external fees. I cannot leave them with the family because I want to raise them properly. I am waiting for the money you'll send me telegraphically so I can pay for the schooling. I intend to put them in the boarding section because it is better for the children. Otherwise, I will put them in the external section but I have to live alone. I am not saying that the family is bad, no. But it's better for me and for the children's education to do it this way. Please answer me immediately.

Please tell us about dear Julia and about your health. Everyone here sends their regards.
