Please send us money urgently so we can live and spend on the children's school, etc. From here everybody, young and old, send you their warm greetings. Your father and mother and folks send you their greetings and bless you and wish you success and long life. And they also want you to send money urgently. Please give my greetings to all the folks who pass by you.

P.S. When you receive my letter it will be Christmas. I want to greet you on this occasion on the birthday of the Lord Jesus Christ, our Savior, hoping that you will spend many years in good health and prosperity.
